

In this top-down action game you have to rescue the kidnaped Princess Diana from the Tower of Evil, and find the King's lost treasure that had been stolen by an



evil necromancer. The game's minimum requirements are an Amiga with Original Chip Set (OCS), 0.5Mb Chip RAM, and 0.5Mb or more Fast RAM.

be slow because of the multi-threaded architecture of this player.







Last month's issue of <u>WAUG News</u> (October, 2024) included news of the release by developer Grzegorz Kraszewski of the logic game **Untangle** for the Amiga. In this game, the player has a number of dots in front of him, which are connected by lines and cross each other. The aim of the game is to untangle the lines by moving the dots so that no line intersects another.

Grzegorz has now released version 1.1 with the following changes:

- Fixed a bug of freeing a memory block twice at game end.
- Added the game ending displaying total number of moves and time spent.
- Added 25 more levels, now the game has 175 levels.

The game runs in a Workbench window, a standard Amiga 1200 is sufficient. It is free at the download link below.


Versatile Amiga Testprogram v 6.7β

<u>WAUG News</u> reported on version 6.3 beta of Jochem Caspers' **Versatile Amiga Testprogram** in our last issue (October 2024). Since then, this utility has gone to version 6.7 beta. The available tests are: Screen, Audio, Sprite, Blitter, CD32 joypad, Keyboard, CIA, ROM, CPU, FPU, RTC, Memory, Address-line, Real Interrupt, Interrupt Request, Disk-drive, Parallel-port and Serial-Port.

Remove hardware from the parallel port when doing tests on this port and real interrupt testing. Don't use Amitestkit or diagrom testplugs! Remove parallel port test plug when done using the program.

The game **Squarez** is a remake of the Flash game SQUARES 2 (2010+). It is an action game and is played with the mouse.


